6647: Exmoor Lawns – Electricity Supply:

Members were reminded that the decision to install an electricity supply on Exmoor Lawns was made on the basis that the expectation was that the site would be used for functions and events on a regular basis particularly during the summer months. The use of generators, as at the 2019 Lorna Doone Festival, for future events would be costly in comparison, noisy and environmentally unfriendly. The total current available via a fixed installation is at a much greater level and more suited to the anticipated demand.

a) Pillar Cabinet – Charles Endirect
