Matters Arising:

All Saints Church School House Boundary Wall:

Members were informed that further advice is being sourced from a specialist concerning what proposals can be considered with regards the rebuilding of the collapsed wall.

Barnsclose – SWW Works:

The Clerk continues to pursue South West Water, through German Fisher with regards the following:

1)The extended lease as from 29th July 2023 until 30th November as South West Water has proposed.

2) The payment of the £200 per week (*payable in advance*) due for the period 29th July 2023 until 30th November 2023

3) Details of the proposed refurbishment of the play ground

Grounds Work – Hourly Rate 2024/25.

After discussion it was:

Parish Lengthsman Scheme 2024/25:
